

She reviewed Victoria's artwork and immediately loved 'The Brocco' the best, especially the white hound named 'Angel' at the bottom of the image. Originally from Millhouses, she still considers Sheffield her true home and misses it. She now lives in Salt Lake City and took the painting back to USA in her luggage!

Pablo Ruiz Picasso

In 1950, Pablo Picasso stayed here whilst attending the World Peace Congress in Sheffield. During his visit he drew a simple Dove on a napkin whilst having dinner, as a symbol of World Peace.

In honour of this, the dove is now a symbol of Brocco's peace and tranquility.
